FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – March 2018

From March 1, 2018 to March 31, 2018, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 81.3%. The save rate for dogs was 96.3% and for cats it was 57.6%. Last month 27 feral cats were euthanized as per the current policies and procedures.

The save rate does not include 18 dogs that were owner requested euthanasia for the entire month of March 2018.

Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
