FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – August 2019

From August 1, 2019 through August 31, 2019, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 95% and for cats it was 91%.\* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 92.8%\*\*

• 162 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for August 2019.

## Dogs:

- One dog was an owner requested euthanasia due to aggressive behavior.
- One dog was humanely euthanized after complications from spay surgery.
- One dog died en route after being found unresponsive in the field.
- One dog died en route to vet clinic after being found unresponsive in the field.
- Three dogs died from Parvo complications.
- One puppy died in foster.
- Two dogs were lost in care.

## Cats:

In August we had a number of kittens who presented with illness before they are brought into the shelter and kittens who failed to thrive..

- In August, we lost 7 kittens under 5 months old that died in care and were either failure to thrive or had upper respiratory infections that did not respond to treatment.
- One kitten died at the vet that was severely injured on intake.
- Three kittens died en route to the shelter from injuries sustained prior to being picked up.
- Two kittens died in foster, failure to thrive.
- Four adult cats died as a result of injuries in the field and either en route to the shelter or at a vet clinic.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.

- \*Formula used to include Owner Requested Euthanasia and head to lab bite investigations: Intake minus all euthanasia outcomes divided by intake minus owner requested euthanasia
- \*\* Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes
