FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – July 2019

From July 1, 2019 through July 31, 2019, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 94%. The save rate for dogs was 98% and for cats it was 90%.* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 93.3%**

• 113 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for July 2019.

Dogs:

- One dog was an owner requested euthanasia due age and health.
- One dog at FBCAS after testing positive for Parvo
- One dog was humanely euthanized after complications from spay surgery.
- One dog died in care after being found unresponsive in the field.
- One dog was lost in care.

Cats:

Once again, we had a number of kittens who come in as neonates who failed to thrive and the babies who are already suffering from illness before they are brought into the shelter.

- In July, we lost 14 kittens under 5 months old that died in care and were either failure to thrive or had upper respiratory infections that did not respond to treatment.
- Two cats died in care. One cat was severely injured on intake. Once community cat failed to thrive.
- One cat was humanely euthanized as part of a heat to lab bite investigation.
- Five cats were humanely euthanized for medical reasons.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.

- *Formula used to include Owner Requested Euthanasia and head to lab bite investigations: Intake minus all euthanasia outcomes divided by intake minus owner requested euthanasia
- ** Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes
