FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – November 2019

From November 1, 2019 through November 30, 2019, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 95%. The save rate for dogs was 97% and for cats it was 93%.* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 94%**

- 102 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for November 2019.

Dogs:

- One dog died in care after complications from surgery.
- One dog was lost in care.
- Three dogs were humanely euthanized as part of head-to-lab bite investigations.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized for severe aggressive behavior.
- One dog died from extensive injuries after being hit by a car.

Cats:

- One senior cat (12) was humanely euthanized for multiple complications from old age and malnutrition.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized after not responding to treatment for multiple health issues.
- One cat died in care after complications from a upper respiratory infection.
- One kitten died in foster for failing to thrive.
- Four kittens died with complications from upper respiratory infections and failing to thrive.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
