FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – October 2019

From October 1, 2019 through October 31, 2019, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 97% and for cats it was 85%.* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 90.2%**

• 108 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for October 2019.

Dogs:

- Two dogs died while in medical foster.
- One dog died after complications from abdominal surgery.
- One dog was humanely euthanized after being found severely injured and unresponsive in the field.
- One dog died after being brought in unresponsive.
- One dog was lost in care.
- Two dogs were euthanized for head-to-lab bite investigations

Cats:

In October we had a number of kittens who presented with illness before they are brought into the shelter and kittens who failed to thrive.

- In October, we lost 24 kittens under 5 months old that died in care and were either failure to thrive or had upper respiratory infections that did not respond to treatment.
- One cat died at an outside vet after being hit by a car and sent for care.
- One cat died after being brought in unresponsive.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized after suffering extensive injuries in the field.
- One cat was lost in care.
- One cat was an owner requested euthanasia, the cat was geriatric and very ill.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.

- *Formula used to include Owner Requested Euthanasia and head to lab bite investigations: Intake minus all euthanasia outcomes divided by intake minus owner requested euthanasia
- ** Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes

^{*} Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
