FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – September 2019

From September 1, 2019 through September 30, 2019, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 96% and for cats it was 88%.* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 90.3%**

- 112 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for September 2019.

Dogs:

- One puppy died after failing to thrive.
- One dog died after complications from spay surgery.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized after being found severely injured and unresponsive in the field.
- One dog died from Parvo complications.
- Four dogs were euthanized for head-to-lab bite investigations

Cats:

In September we had a number of kittens who presented with illness before they are brought into the shelter and kittens who failed to thrive.

- In September, we lost 19 kittens under 5 months old that died in care and were either failure to thrive or had upper respiratory infections that did not respond to treatment.
- One kitten was humanely euthanized after not responding to treatment.
- Two kittens were humanely euthanized after return from foster care, failure to thrive.
- One adult cat died in foster.
- One adult cat died in care from complications of a URI.
- One community cat died after spay surgery.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.

*Formula used to include Owner Requested Euthanasia and head to lab bite investigations: Intake minus all euthanasia outcomes divided by intake minus owner requested euthanasia
