FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – August 2020

From August 1, 2020 through August 31, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 99%. The save rate for dogs was 98% and for cats it was 99%.*

- 180 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for August 2020.
- 16 dogs and 3 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs for August 2020.

Dogs:

- Two dogs were owner requested euthanasia for head to lab bite investigations.

Cats:

- Two cats suffered severe injuries in the field and were humanely euthanized.
- One community cat died after surgery.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

Since August 2018 FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets that come into our shelter. Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
