FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report - June 2020

From June 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 97%. The save rate for dogs was 96% and for cats it was 98%.\*

- 157 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for June 2020.
- 4 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return in Field program for June 2020.

## Dogs:

- Four dogs were humanely euthanized as head to lab bite investigations as requested by their owners.
- · One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe medical condition.

## Cats:

- 3 neonatal kittens died in foster.
- 1 neonatal kitten died, failure to thrive.
- · 1 neonatal kitten died from severe injuries on arrival.
- 1 Community Cat was humanely euthanized due to its severe medical condition.
- . 1 cat was humanely euthanized at the shelter due to severe injuries sustained in the field.
