FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – October 2021

From October 1, 2021 through October 31, 2021, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 94% and for cats it was 92%. *

- 139 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 24 dogs and 4 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- One senior passed away in foster care.
- One dog died from post-surgical complications.
- Three newborns passed away hours after birth
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized after bite investigations.
- One was humanely euthanized due to severe injury.
- One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of the owner.

Cats:

- Three cats was humanely euthanized after being hit by a car.
- Four neonatal kittens died in foster care for failing to thrive.
- Three community cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- Five kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- One cat was humanely euthanized at the request of the owner.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
