## **FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – February 2022**

From February 1, 2022 through February 28, 2022, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 97%. The save rate for dogs was 98% and for cats it was 96%. \*

- 104 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 25 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

### **Dogs:**

- One dog died after being involved in a car accident and brought to the shelter.
- One senior dog died from unknown causes.
- One dog was humanely euthanized at the owners request for aggressive behavior.

### **Cats:**

- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness.
- Two community cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
- One cat was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries in the field.

\* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

\*Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes
