## **FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – October 2022**

From October 1, 2022 through October 31, 2022, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 88% and for cats it was 91%.\*

FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets in our care since August 2018.

- 67 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 13 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

### **Dogs:**

- Six newborn puppies died shortly after birth.
- One severely ill puppy was humanely euthanized (failure to thrive).
- One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries in the field
- One dog was humanely euthanized for multiple bites.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public.

### **Cats:**

- One kitten was humanely euthanized for severe illness.
- Eight neonatal kittens died due to failure to thrive (one in foster care and seven at the shelter).

\* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
