FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – December 2023

From December 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, the overall save rate was 92%. The save rate for dogs it was 90% and for cats it was 95%.

As we move forward though, we need your help more than ever to continue to keep our save rate at 90% or more. We are in a crisis situation unlike any we have seen here before and we need your help to adopt and foster. Please help us to help them.

- 86 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 6 dogs and 3 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

Dogs:

- One dog was humanely euthanized at the emergency vet after suffering multiple injuries in the field
- One dog was humanely euthanized after being in fospice care
- One dog was humanely euthanized as part of a bite investigation
- Six dogs were humanely euthanized for aggressive behavior towards the public and staff

Cats:

- One kitten died of unknown causes
- Three cats died after suffering severe illness or injury in the field
- One cat died from an unknown illness

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population. Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
