## **FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – May 2023**

From May 1, 2023 through May 31, 2023, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 92% and for cats it was 90%.\*

FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets in our care since August 2018.

- 61 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 11 dogs and one cat were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

### **Dogs:**

- One dog died after a sudden illness
- Two neonatal puppies were humanely euthanized – failure to thrive
- One dog was humanely euthanized – picked up with severe injuries
- Five dogs were humanely euthanized for bites and or aggressive behavior towards the public and staff

### **Cats:**

- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries in the field
- One cat was humanely euthanized due to severe illness
- Three neonatal kittens were humanely euthanized – failure to thrive
- Three kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries in the field
- One kitten was humanely euthanized due to severe illness
- Eight neonatal kittens died in care, three in foster – failure to thrive

\* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
