FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – July 2024

From July 1, 2024 through July 31, 2024, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 92%. The save rate for dogs was 96% and for cats it was 90%.*

FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets in our care since August 2018.

- · 33 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 13 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

Dogs:

- Two puppies died of unknown causes
- One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of its owner for a bite
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public

Cats:

- · Four neonatal kittens died in foster failure to thrive
- · Six neonatal kittens died in shelter failure to thrive
- One kitten died in surgery
- Four kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries
- One cat died in care of unknown causes

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
