FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – June 2024

From June 1, 2024 through June 30, 2024, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 92% and for cats it was 91%.*

FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets in our care since August 2018.

- 88 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 2 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

Dogs:

- Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized as a result of a police/confiscate bite investigation
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public

Cats:

- Two neonatal kittens died of unknown causes
- One neonatal kitten died in foster of unknown causes
- Two cats were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries
- Six kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe illness
- Two kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe injuries

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
