FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – August 2018

From August 1, 2018 to August 31, 2018, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 91%. The save rate for dogs was 96% and for cats it was 85%.*

Last month 16 feral/community cats were euthanized as per current policies and procedures and were not part of our Community Cat Pilot Program.

89 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Pilot Program for Needville and Richmond in July 2018.

The save rate does not include 4 dogs and 3 cats that were owner requested euthanasia for the month of August.

Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
