FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – December 2020

From December 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 97%. The save rate for dogs was 97% and for cats it was 97%.*

- 104 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 23 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.
- · 202 spay/neuter surgeries were performed by our veterinary team.

Dogs:

- Three dogs died from severe injuries suffered out in the field.
- Two dogs died from severe illnesses shortly after surrender to the shelter.

Cats:

- Two community cats were humanely euthanized after being brought in with severe illness.
- One community cat died from severe injuries out in the field.
- One cat died from injuries suffered in the field.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

Since August 2018 FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets that come into our shelter. Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
