From January 1, 2020 through January 31, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 98%. The save rate for dogs was 99.4% and for cats it was 96%.\* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 97%\*\*

January 2020 marks the 18<sup>th</sup> consecutive month that Fort Bend County Animal Services has maintained a 90% or greater save rate for the pets that come into our shelter. This has also been our best month in the history for our shelter pets.

- 114 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for January 2020.
- 8 dogs and 3 cats were returned to their owners through our Return in Field program for January 2020.

## Dogs:

- One dog was humanely euthanized after being picked up with severe medical issues.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized as part of head-to-lab bite investigations.
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized at the request of their owner for displaying severe aggression.

## Cats:

- One cat died in route to the shelter after being injured in the field.
- One cat died on arrival to the shelter after being injured in the field.
- Three TNR cats were humanely euthanized after being dropped off with severe medical conditions not conducive to being returned to locations found.
- One TNR kitten died after failing to thrive.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.

- \*Formula used to include Owner Requested Euthanasia and head to lab bite investigations: Intake minus all euthanasia outcomes divided by intake minus owner requested euthanasia
- \*\* Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes
