FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – July 2020

From July 1, 2020 through July 31, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 95%. The save rate for dogs was 98% and for cats it was 93%.*

- 207 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for July
 2020. This was the highest number of cats that have come through our program in one month since the program's inception in June, 2018.
- 29 dogs and 3 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs for July 2020.

Dogs:

- Four dogs were humanely euthanized as head to lab bite investigations as requested by their owners.
- · One dog died after an illness which was treated by our medical staff.

Cats:

- 5 neonatal/kittens died in foster.
- 3 community cats were humanely euthanized due to severe medical condition.
- 5 neonatal/kittens were humanely euthanized due to severe medical condition.
- 4 cats were humanely euthanized due to serious injuries sustained in the field.
- 1 cat was humanely euthanized at the request of its owner due to age and medical condition.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month. We appreciate all of the support that our pets have received during this difficult time and appreciate everyone's efforts on their behalf.
