FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – April 2020

From April 1, 2020 through April 30, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 99%. The save rate for dogs was 100% and for cats it was 98%.* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 97%**

- 81 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for April 2020.
- 1 dog and 1 cat were returned to their owners through our Return in Field program for April 2020.

Dogs:

· Three dogs were humanely euthanized as head to lab bite investigations.

Cats:

- Two neonatal kittens (5 days old) were humanely euthanized. They were picked up in the field with severe traumatic injuries.
- * Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
