FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – May 2020

From May 1, 2020 through May 31, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 95%. The save rate for dogs was 100% and for cats it was 92%.* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 94%**

- 98 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for May 2020.
- 5 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return in Field program for May 2020.

Dogs:

- Two dogs were humanely euthanized as head to lab bite investigations as requested by their owners.
- · One dog was humanely euthanized as requested by their owner for severe medical reasons.

Cats:

- · 14 neonatal kittens died in foster.
- 5 neonatal kittens were humanely euthanized for severe injuries when picked up.
- 1 community cat died in surgery.
- * Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
