FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – September 2020

From September 1, 2020 through September 30, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 95.6%. The save rate for dogs was 96% and for cats it was 95%.*

- 167 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for September.
- · 32 dogs and 4 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs for September.
- 256 spay/neuter surgeries were performed by our veterinary team in September.

Dogs:

- · Four dogs were humanely euthanized as part of head-to-lab bite investigations.
- One senior dog was an owner requested euthanasia, the dog was suffering from stomach cancer.

Cats:

- · 11 neonatal kittens died in foster care or at the shelter
- Two adult cats were humanely euthanized for severe injuries suffered out in the field after being hit by cars.
- One cat was humanely euthanized for severe injuries after being attacked by a dog out in the field.
- One cat was humanely euthanized after being brought in as a stray and severely injured.

Since August 2018 FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets that come into our shelter. Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.

*Best Friends Community Dashboard formula: [(Live Intakes, including Owner Requested Euthanasia)-(Died in Care)-(Lost in Care)-(Shelter Euthanasia)-(Owner Requested Euthanasia)] divided by Live Intakes
