

FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – December 2021

From December 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 95%. The save rate for dogs was 97% and for cats it was 93%.*

- · 94 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 41 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- · One puppy died due to severe illness.
- · Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to behavior issues with staff and public.
- One fospice dog was humanely euthanized
- Two dogs were humanely euthanized due to head to lab bite investigations at the request of their owners.
- · One dog was humanely euthanized due to a head to lab investigation.
- One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries suffered in the field.

Cats:

- · One kitten was humanely euthanized due to injuries suffered in the field.
- Three neonatal kittens died in foster care for failing to thrive.
- · One kitten died in shelter failing to thrive.
- Three cats were humanely euthanized due to severe illness or injury.
