## FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – October 2021

From October 1, 2021 through October 31, 2021, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 93%. The save rate for dogs was 94% and for cats it was 92%.\*

- 139 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 24 dogs and 4 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

## Dogs:

- Five died in care.
- · Three were humanely euthanized.
- · One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of the owner.

## Cats:

- · Six died in care.
- · 12 were humanely euthanized.
- · One cat was humanely euthanized at the request of the owner.
