FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – July 2022

From July 1, 2022 through July 31, 2022, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 96%. The save rate for dogs was 98% and for cats it was 96%.*

- · 71 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program.
- 25 dogs and 1 cat returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.

Dogs:

- Two dogs were humanely euthanized at the request of their owners for head to lab bite investigations.
- · One dog was humanely euthanized for severe and repeated aggression towards staff and public.
- · One dog died en route to the shelter after being hit by a car.
- · Two puppies died from post-surgical complications.

Cats:

- · Two neonatal kittens died in foster care (failure to thrive).
- · One neonatal kittens died at the shelter (failure to thrive).
- · Two kittens died shortly after coming in from injuries when picked up in the field.
- · One kitten was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries when picked up in the field.
- One kitten was humanely euthanized due to severe illness while in foster care.

Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
