FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – February 2023

From February 1, 2023 through February 28, 2023, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 94%. The save rate for dogs was 93% and for cats it was 96%.*

FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets in our care since August 2018.

- 58 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 16 dogs and 2 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

Dogs:

- · Two puppies died shortly after birth
- Three dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public
- One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of their owner after a bite investigation
- One dog was humanely euthanized after suffering severe injuries in the field
- · Three dogs were humanely euthanized due to suffering from severe illnesses

Cats:

- · One cat was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries in the field
- · One cat humanely euthanized due to severe illness in the field
- * Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
