

## FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – October 2023

From October 1, 2023 through October 31, 2023, the overall save rate was 94%. The save rate for dogs it was 92% and for cats it was 95%.

As we move forward though, we need your help more than ever to continue to keep our save rate at 90% or more. We are in a crisis situation unlike any we have seen here before and we need your help to adopt and foster. Please help us to help them.

- · 73 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- · 11 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

## Dogs:

- · One dog passed away en route to the shelter after suffering an injury in the field
- · One dog died of unknown causes
- · One puppy died at a local vet office after suffering injuries in the field
- · One dog was humanely euthanized for aggression at the request of their owner
- · Two dogs were humanely euthanized for bites and or aggressive behavior towards the public and staff
- · Two dogs were humanely euthanized by court order after being deemed dangerous
- · Two dogs were humanely euthanized for severe illness/injury

## Cats:

- · Three kittens died in foster care failing to thrive
- · One kitten died from an unknown illness
- · One kitten was humanely euthanized for a severe injury
- · One cat died from an unknown illness
- · One cat was humanely euthanized for a severe injury
- \* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population. Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
