

## TICK-BORNE RELAPSE FEVER

TBRF is a rare infection linked to sleeping in rustic cabins, particularly in mountainous areas of the western US.



## How do people get Relapse Fever?

• The bacteria that cause TBRF are transmitted by certain types of ticks, called "soft" ticks that live in the nests of squirrels, chipmunks, and other small animals.

• People become exposed when they sleep in cabins and other rustic buildings in which rodents have built nests.

## **Symptoms**

Symptoms can reoccur and produce a telltale pattern of fever lasting roughly 3 days, followed by 7 days without fever, followed by another 3 days of fever.
