Fort Bend County Animal Services Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – January 2018

For January 1, 2018 through January 31, 2018, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 86%. The save rate for dogs was 95% and for cats, it was 53%. Last month 19 feral cats were euthanized as per the current policies and procedures.

The save rate does not include 12 dogs that were owner requested euthanasia for the month of January 2018.

Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
