FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – April 2023

From April 1, 2023 through April 30, 2023, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 94%. The save rate for dogs was 91% and for cats it was 96%.*

FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets in our care since August 2018.

- 70 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program
- 10 dogs and 8 cats were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs

Dogs:

- One puppy died shortly after birth
- Two puppies were humanely euthanized due to severe illness
- Five dogs were humanely euthanized due to aggression towards staff and public
- One dog was humanely euthanized at the request of their owner after a bite investigation
- One dog was humanely euthanized as part of a bite investigation
- Three dogs were humanely euthanized due to suffering from severe illnesses

Cats:

- Two newborn kittens died shortly after birth
- One cat was humanely euthanized at the request of their owner after a bite investigation
- One cat humanely euthanized due to severe illness in the field
- Two cats humanely euthanized due to severe injuries in the field

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
